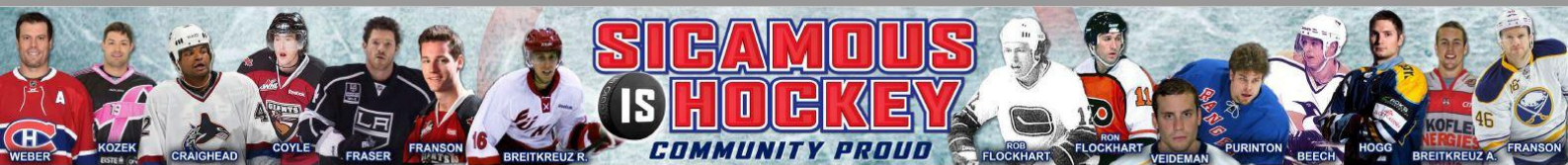




SCAVENGER HUNT
